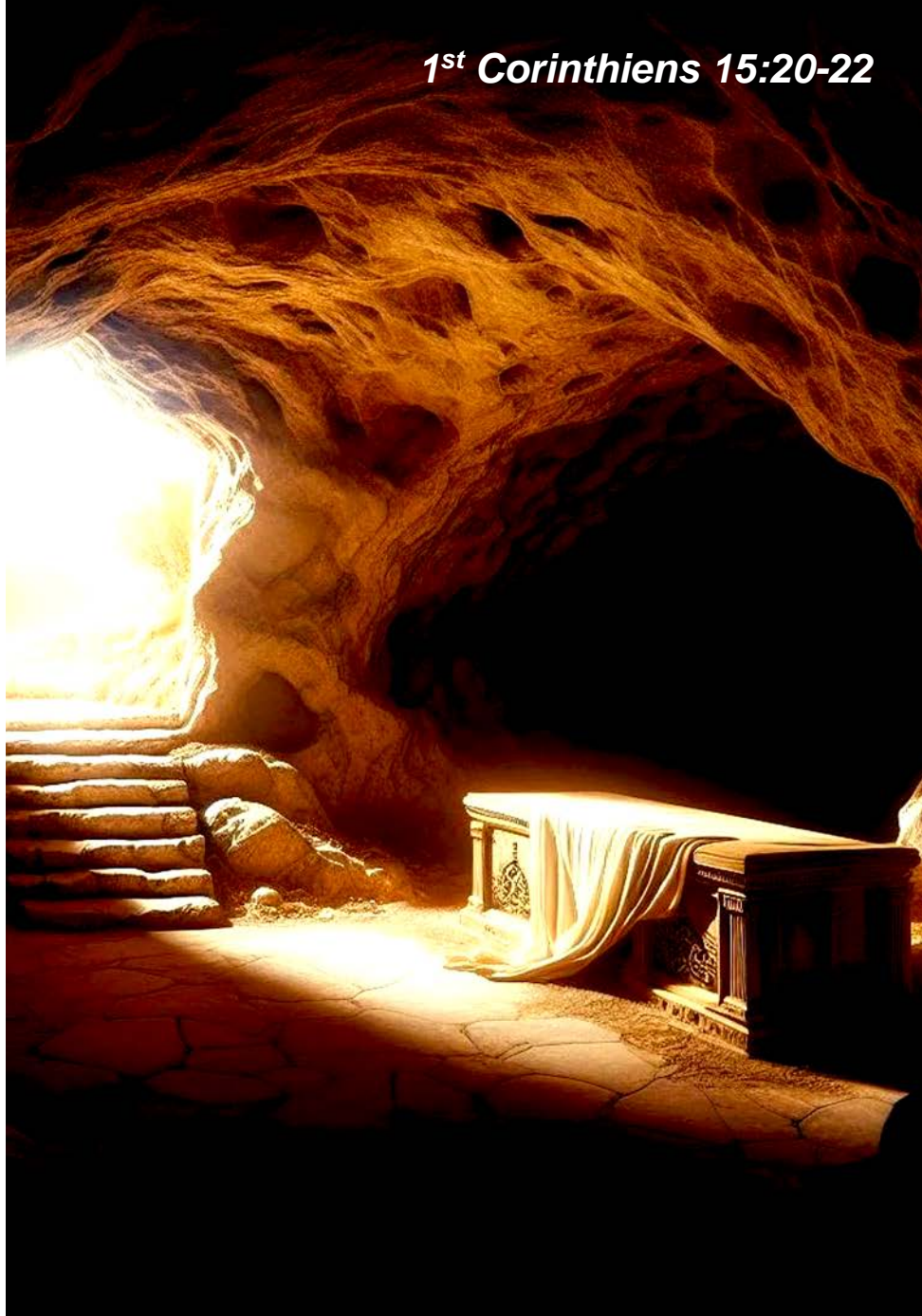
Famines - Pestilences - Wars
