1 Peter 1:19

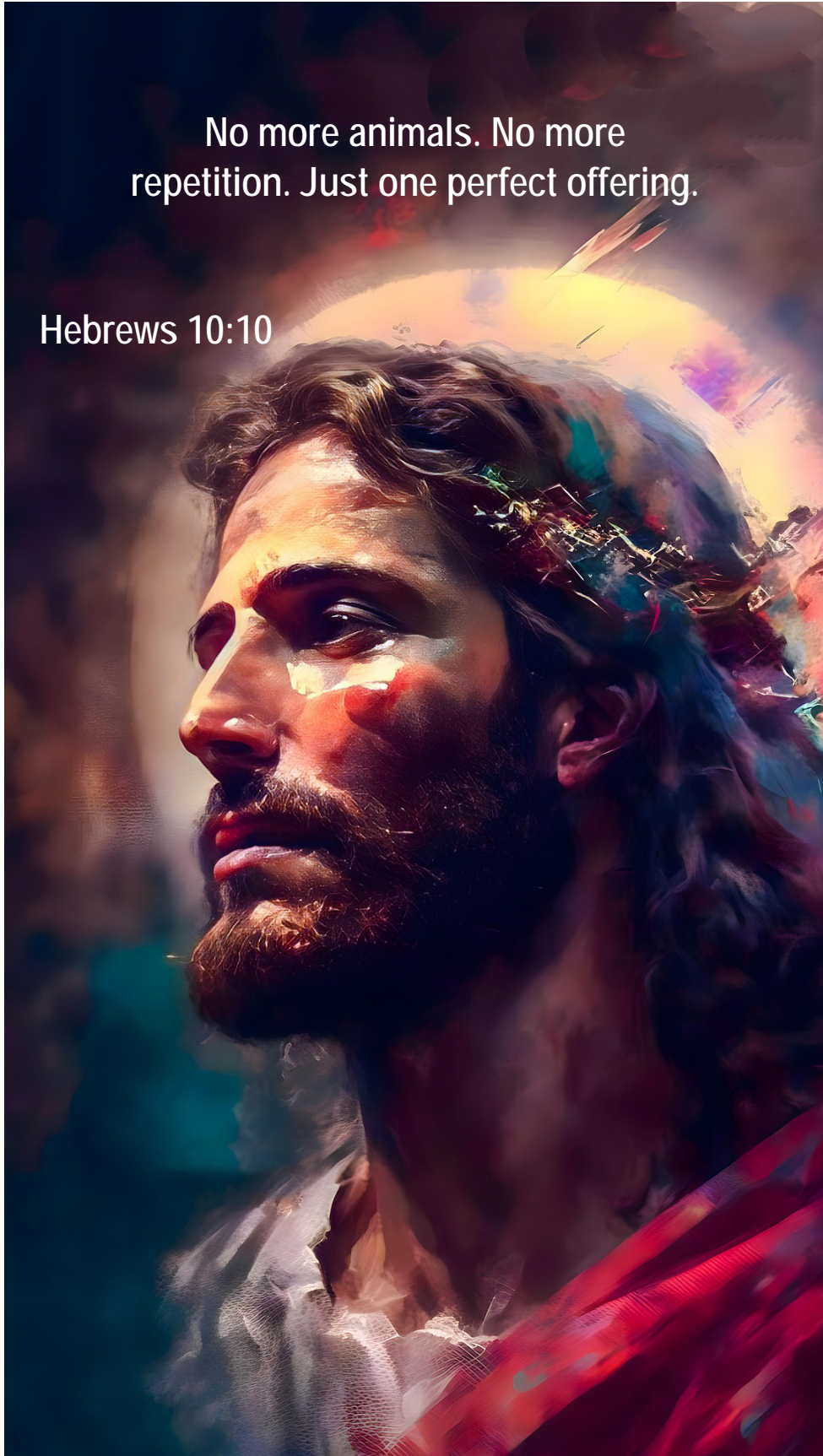


But everything changed with Jesus.

Hebrews 7:27



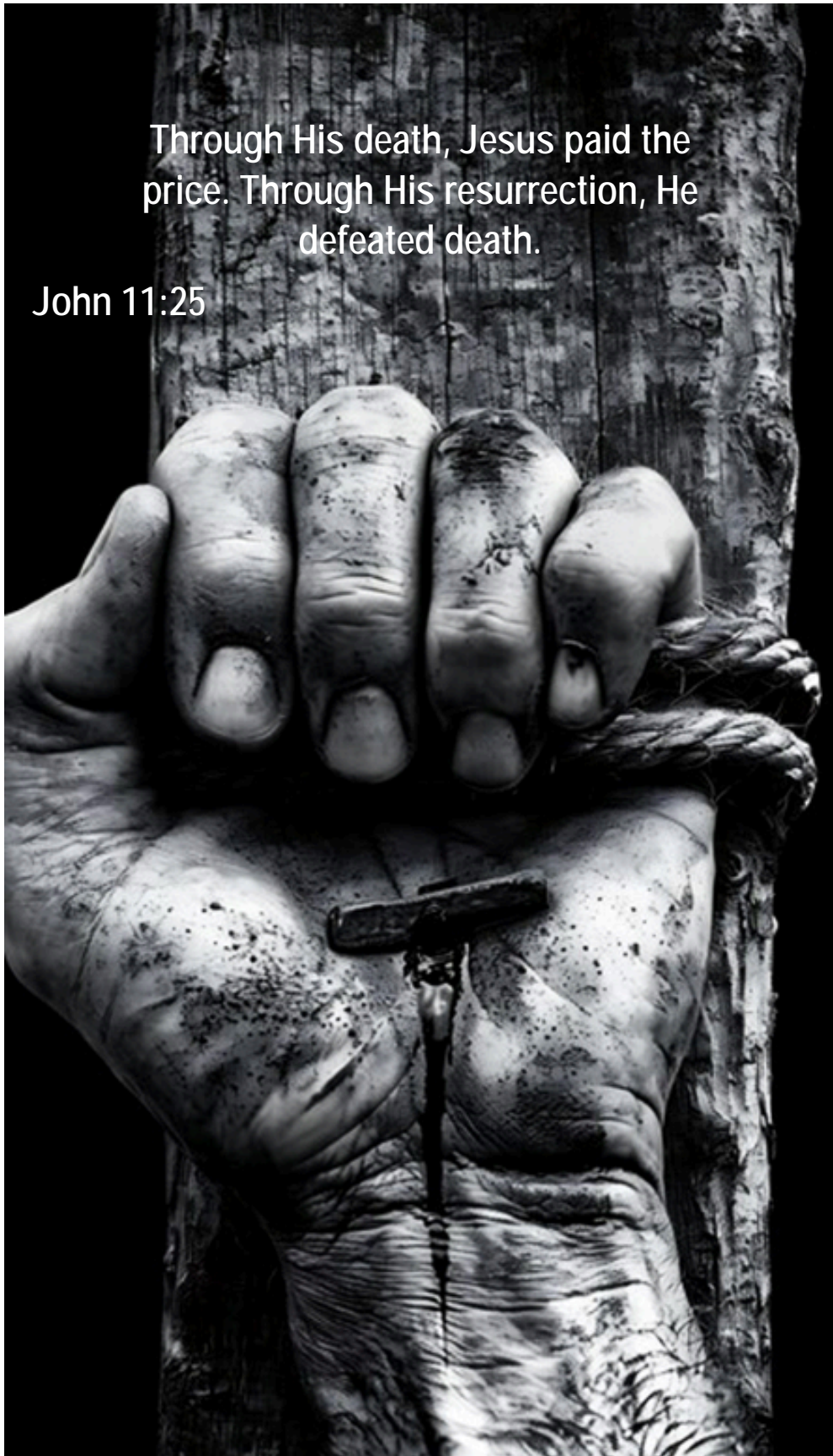
John the Baptist recognized this when he saw Jesus and said, *“Look, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!”*


