

**"Is Biblical Prophecy
Happening Now—in Gaza?"**



Revelation speaks of a *pale horse*, whose rider is *Death*, followed by *Hell*. They're given power to kill with *sword, hunger, and death*.

Revelation 6:8



This resembles what we see daily in Gaza, people are dying not just from bombs, but from hunger—used as a weapon of war.



Starvation is claiming lives silently: children,
the elderly, even infants. Food aid is
sometimes turned into a trap, a deadly snare.



As Job 5:20 says, *"In famine He shall redeem you from death, and in war from the power of the sword."* That's a prayer worth claiming for Gaza or any war zones.



Daniel 8:23 tells us that in the time of the End, transgressors will reach their limit. Did the situation in Gaza reach an intolerable limit? It appears so.



Revelation indicates that 1/4th of the world population will be affected by this "*pale horse*". Could this be but a foreshadow of things to come before the Return of the Lord?



Yet there is *hope*.

God will "*destroy those who destroy
the earth.*"
