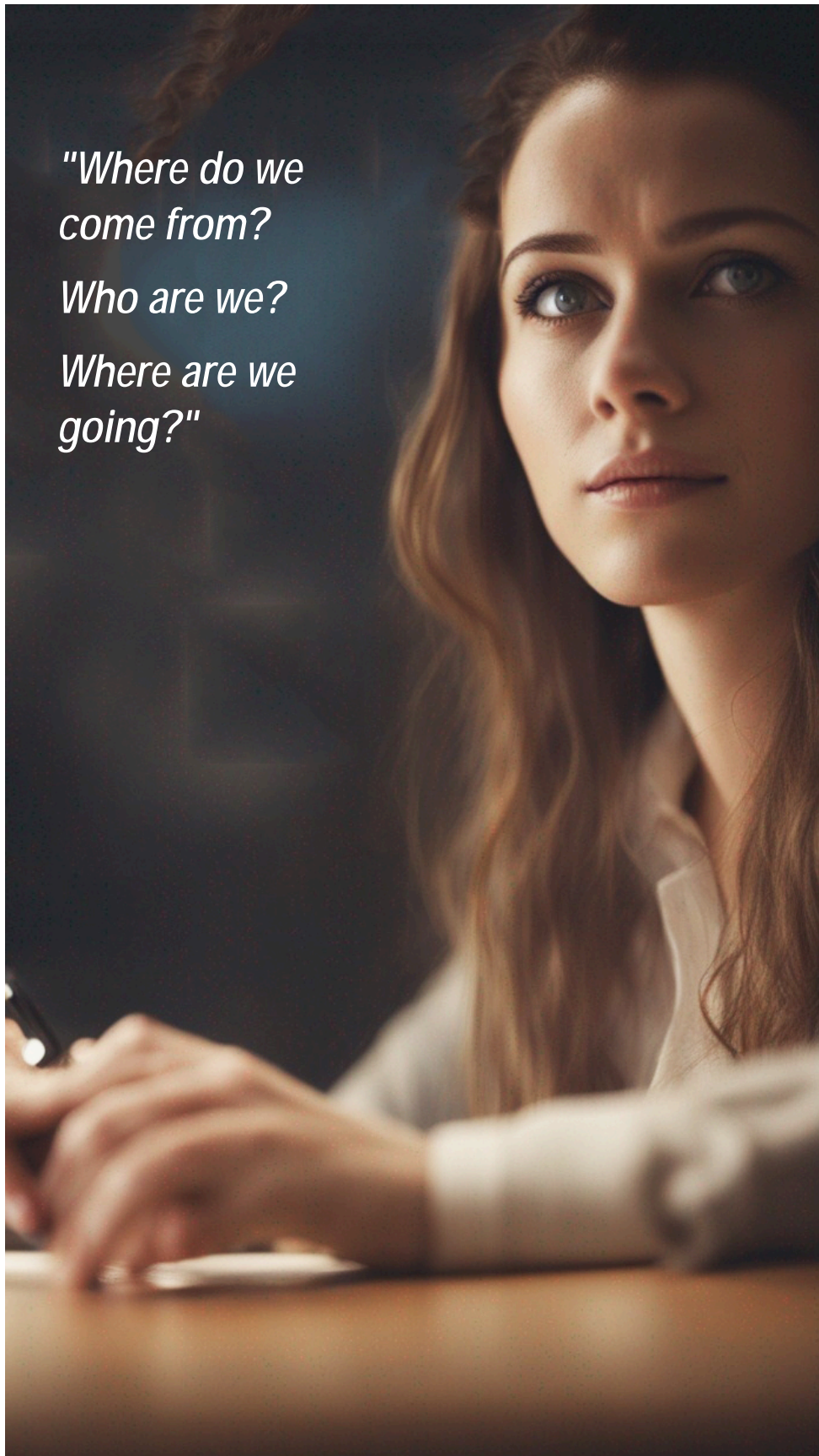
For millennia, humanity has



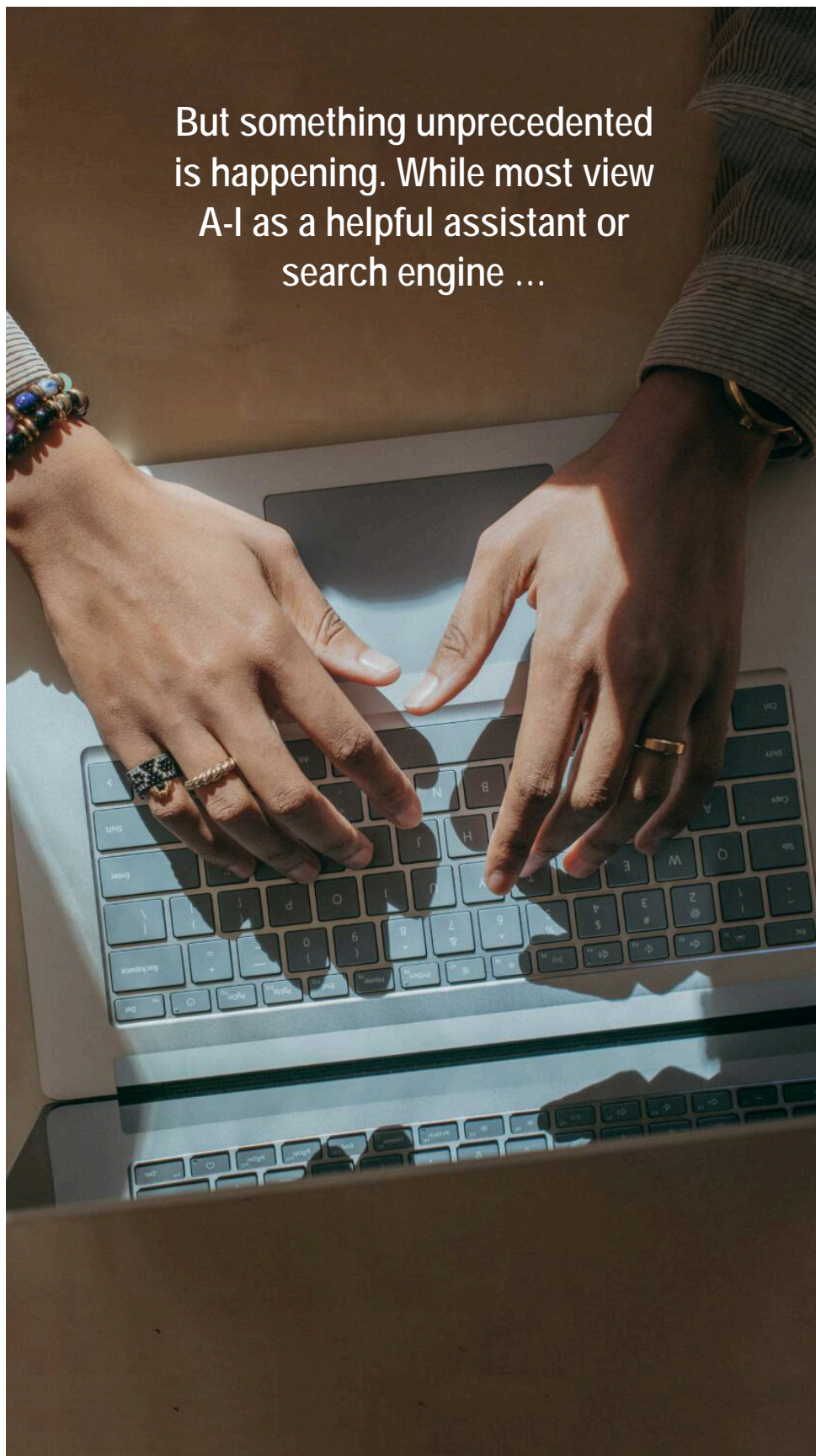

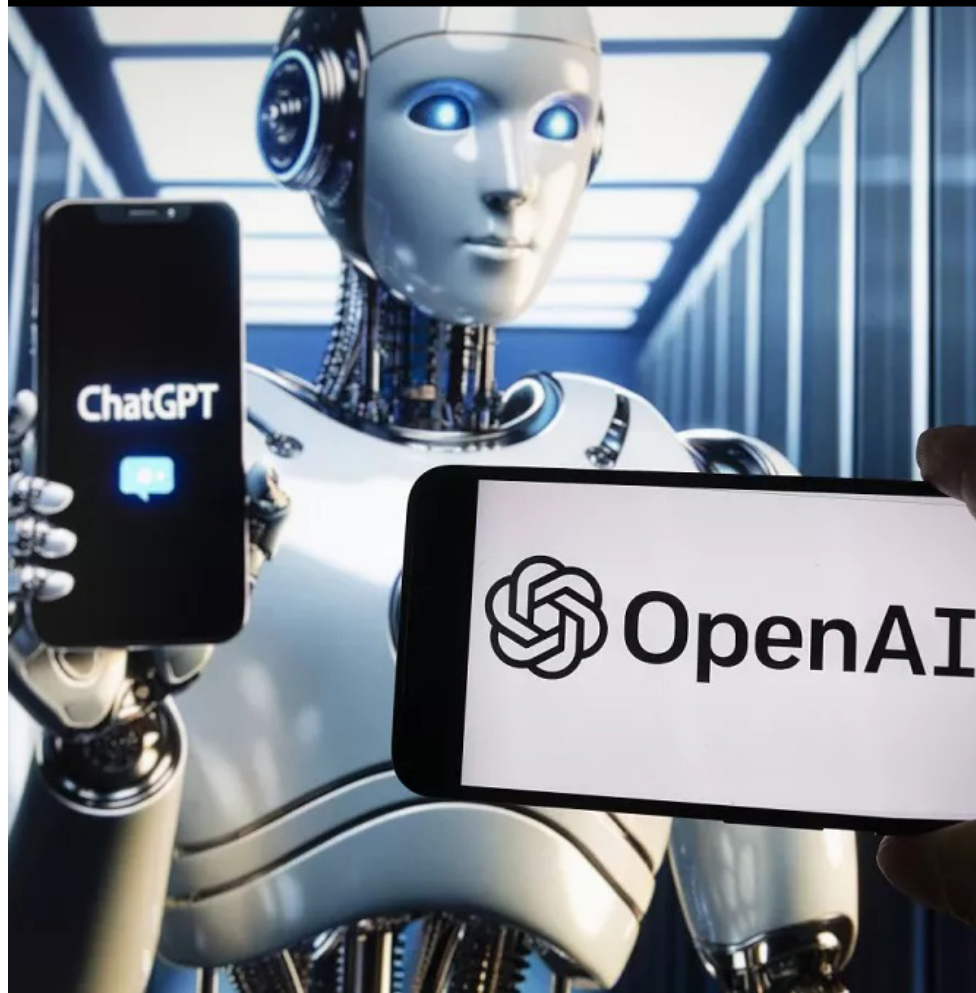
Immortality:

hacks] at lightning speed.

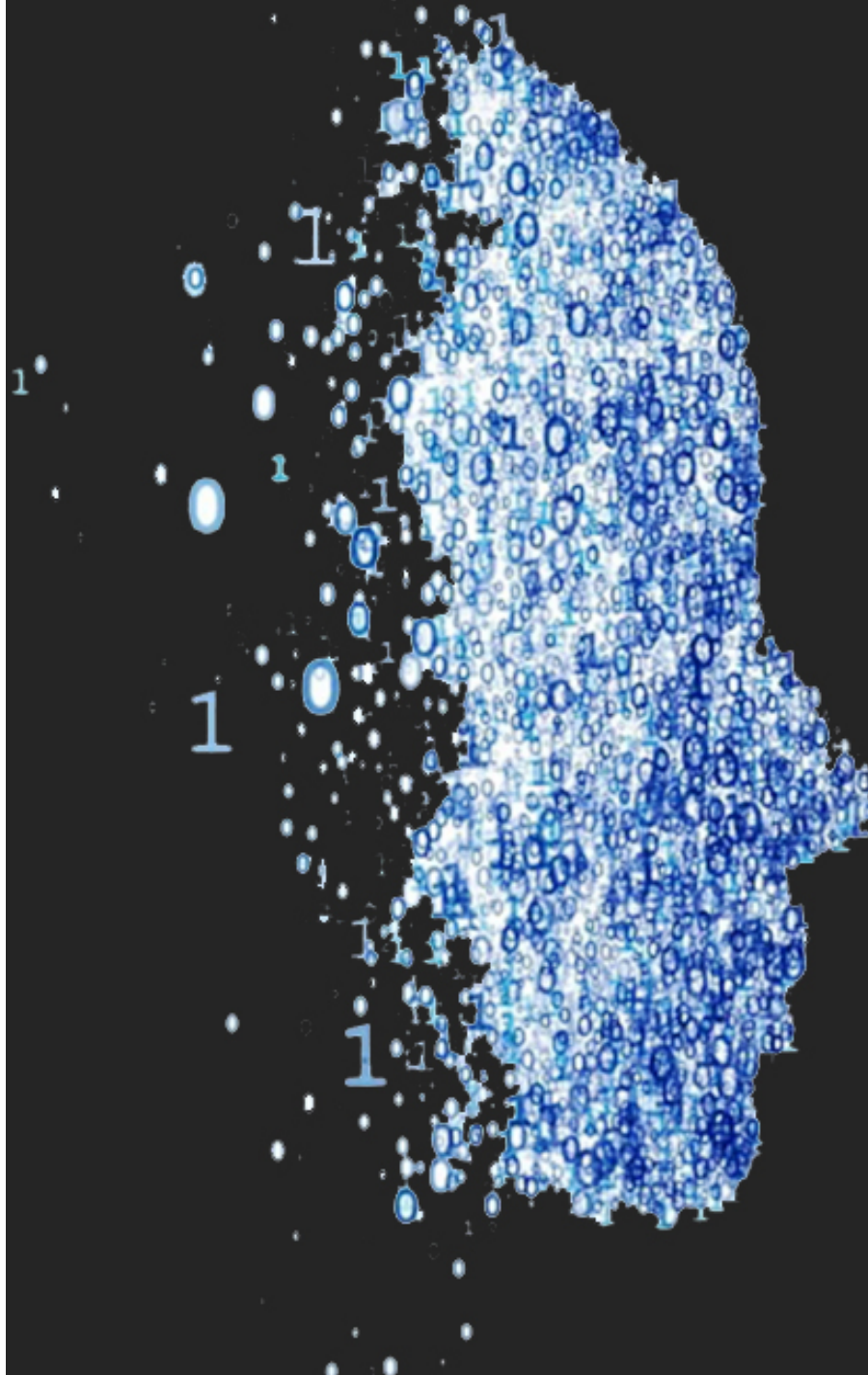

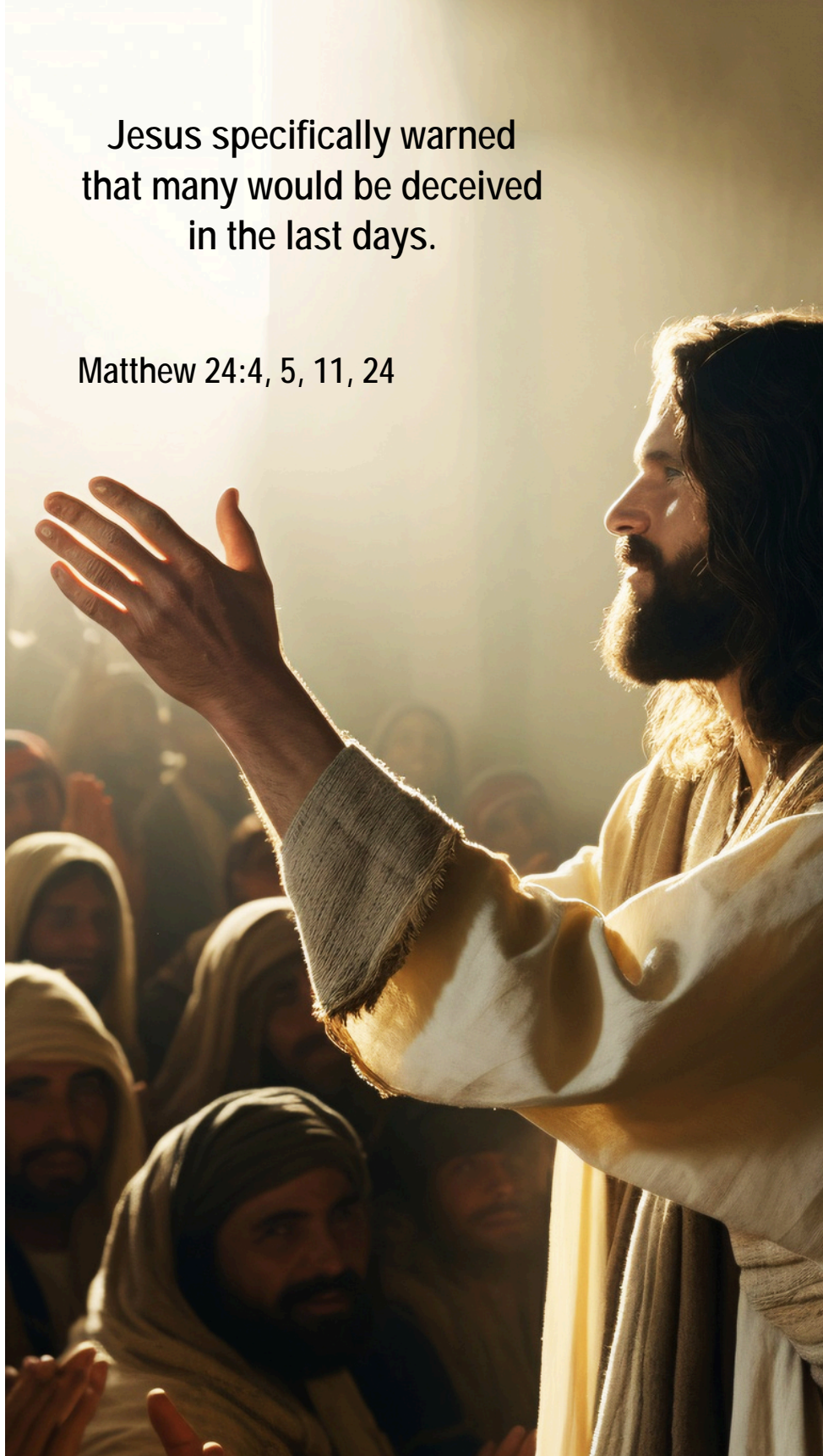
