This figure is described in the writings of the prophet Daniel (@545 BC), St. Paul (@52 AD), and St. John (@90 AD).

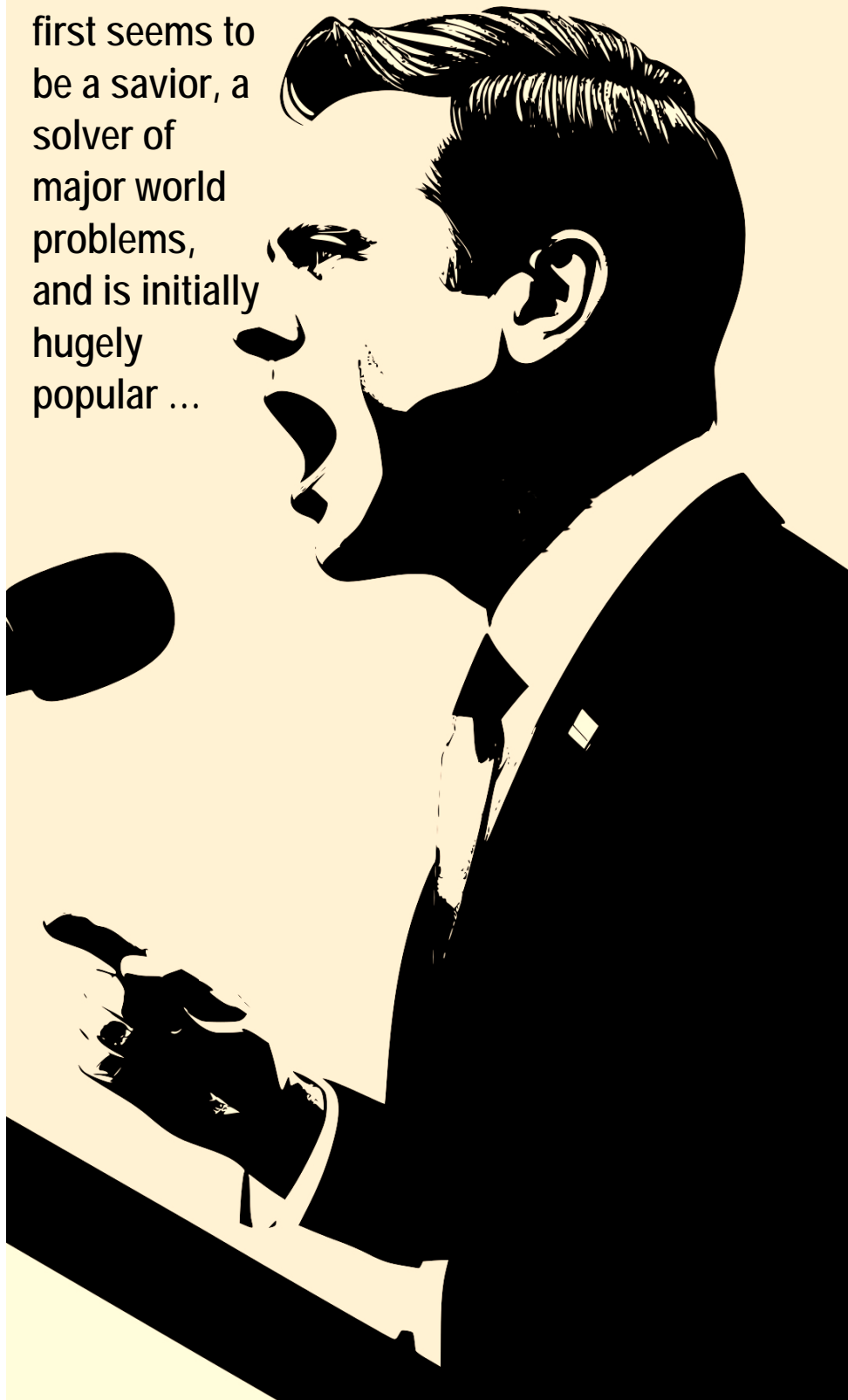



Who is this final dictator? Daniel describes him as a "little horn," who rises among an alliance of ten kings, subduing three of them.

While he at first seems to be a savior, a solver of major world problems, and is initially hugely popular ...





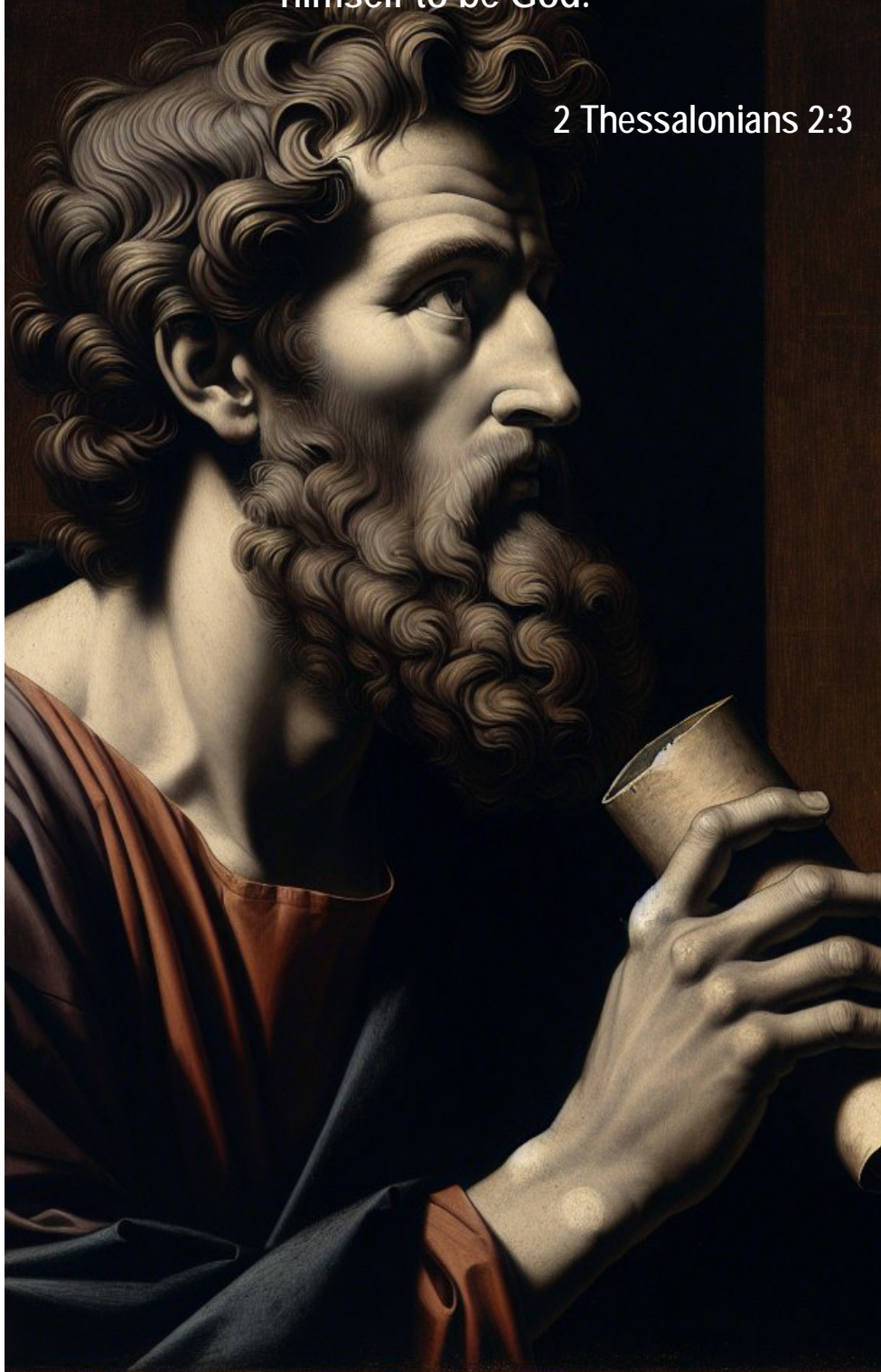
... he's later



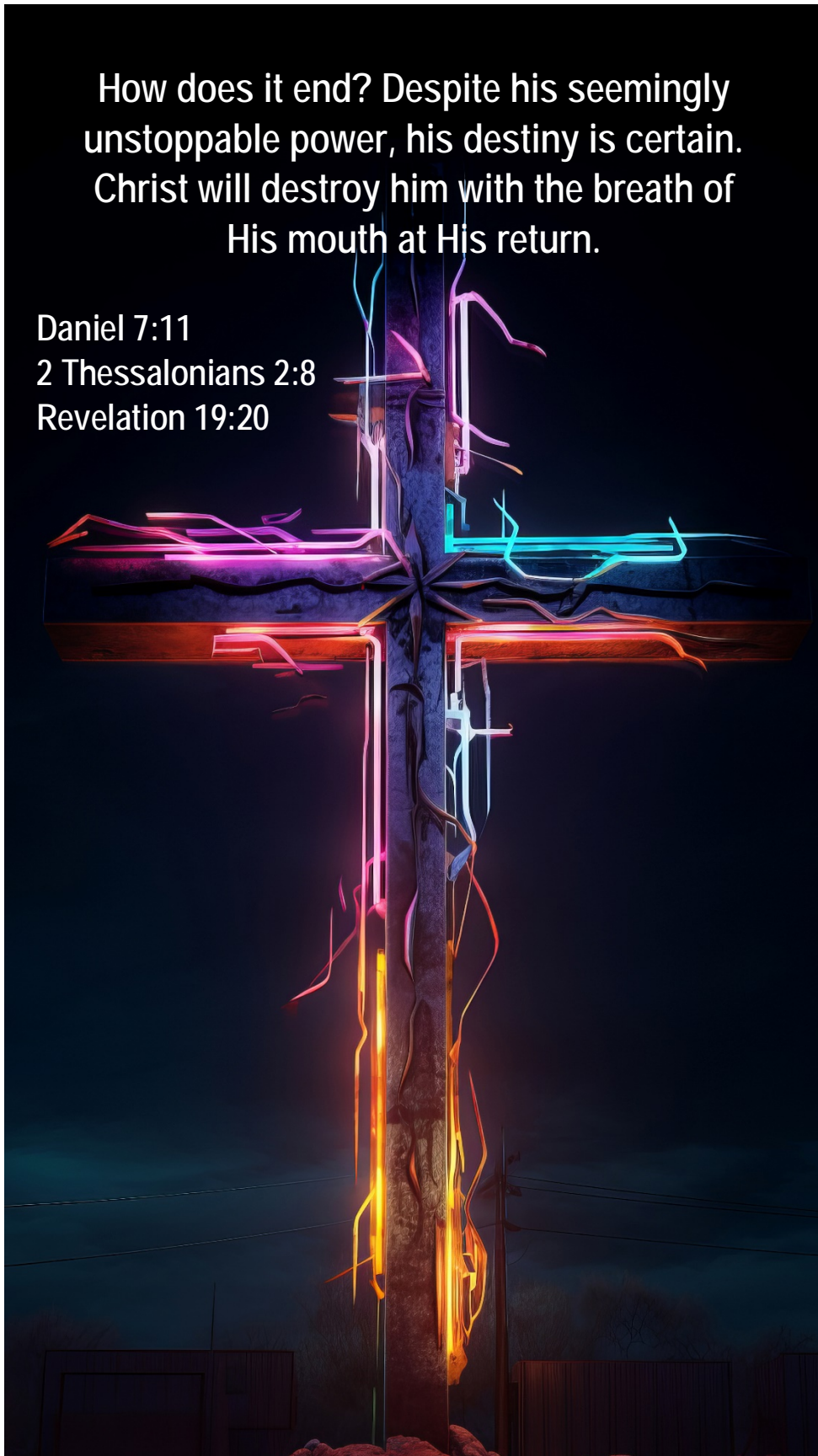


How does it end? Despite his seemingly
