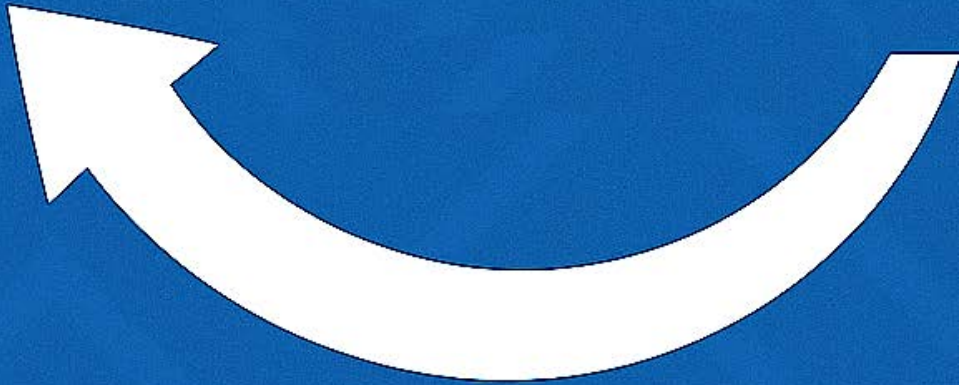

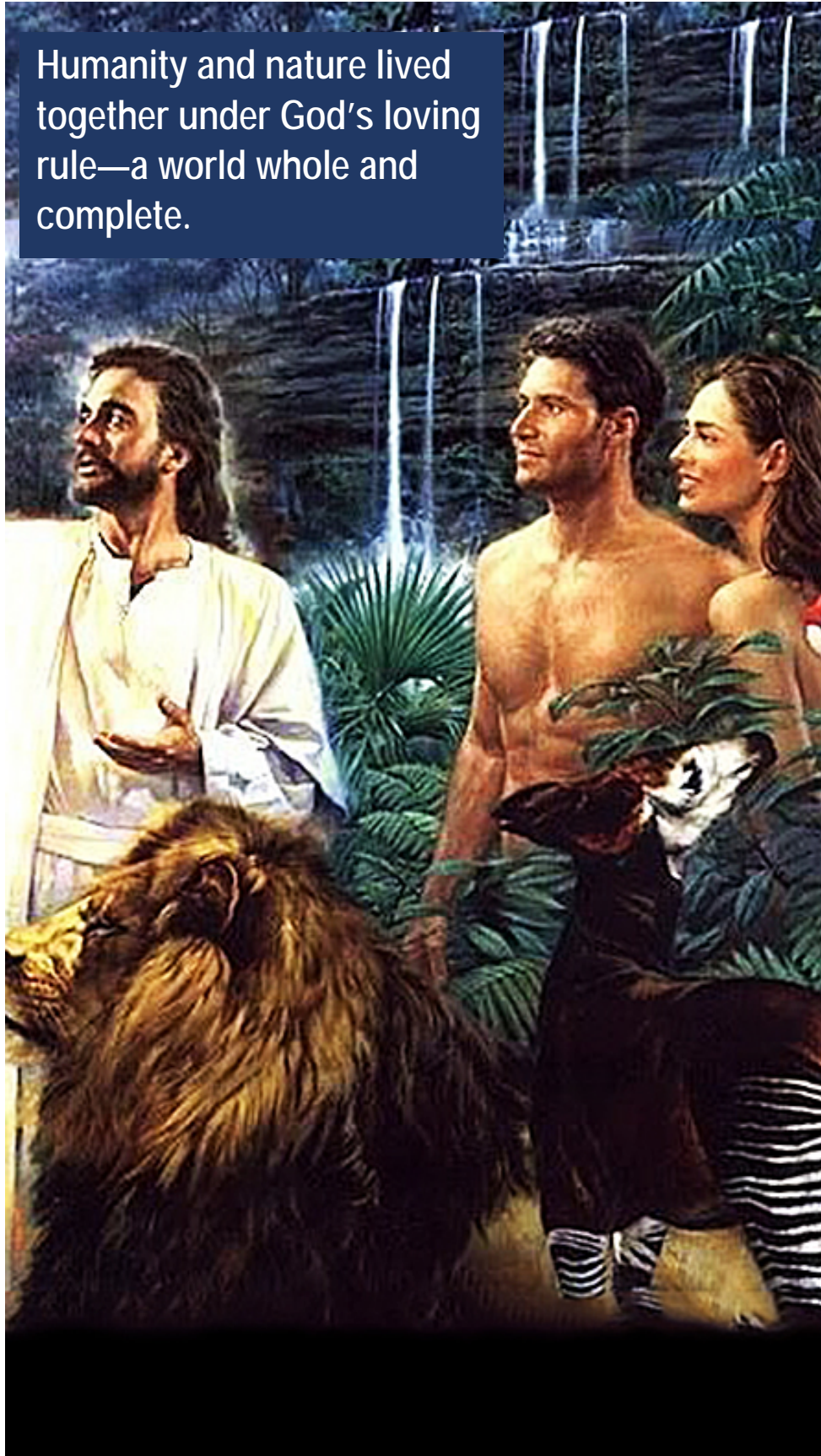
What if the Resurrection wasn't just a miracle—but a new beginning for the entire Earthly Realm?



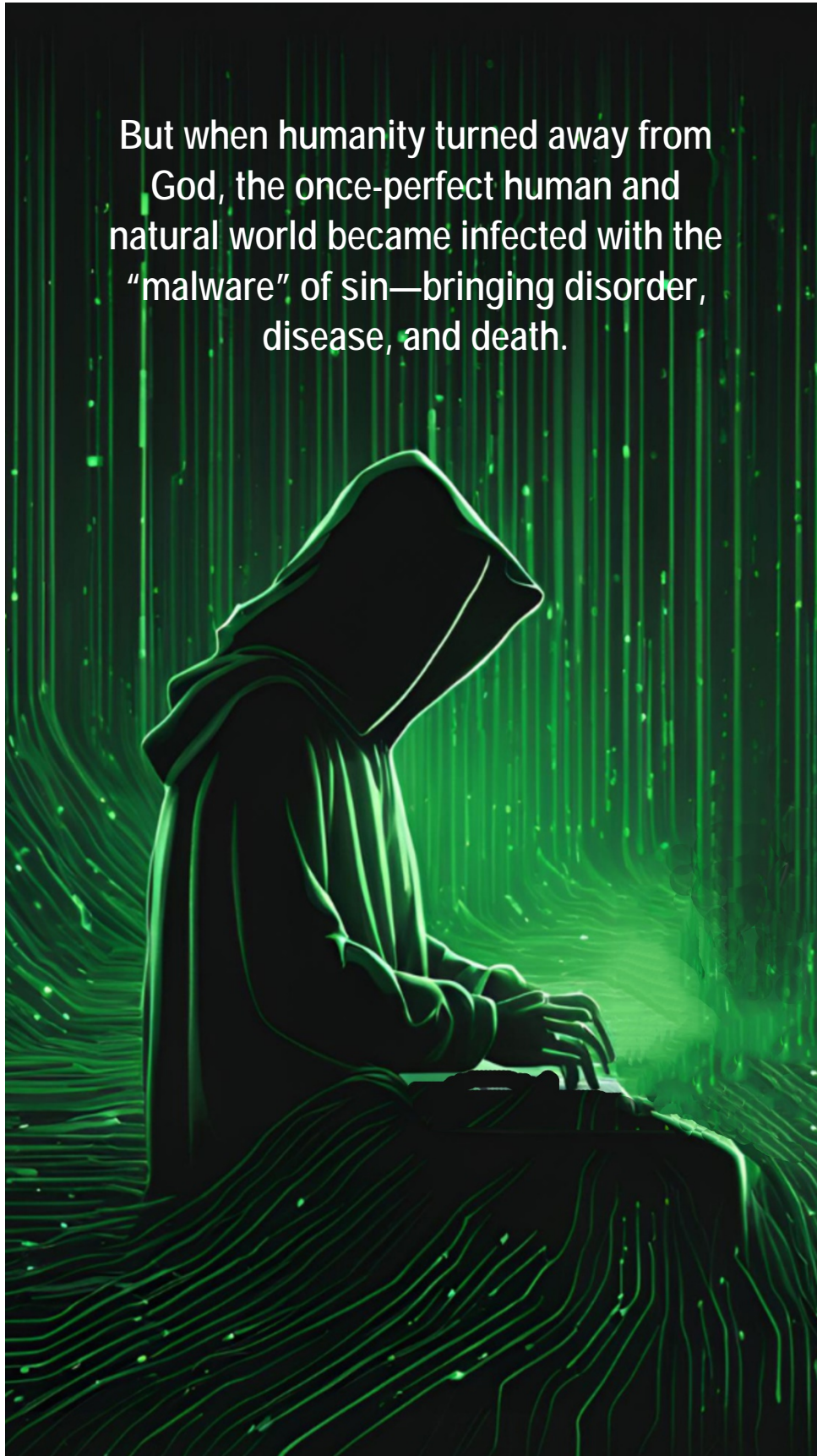
When God created the world, everything

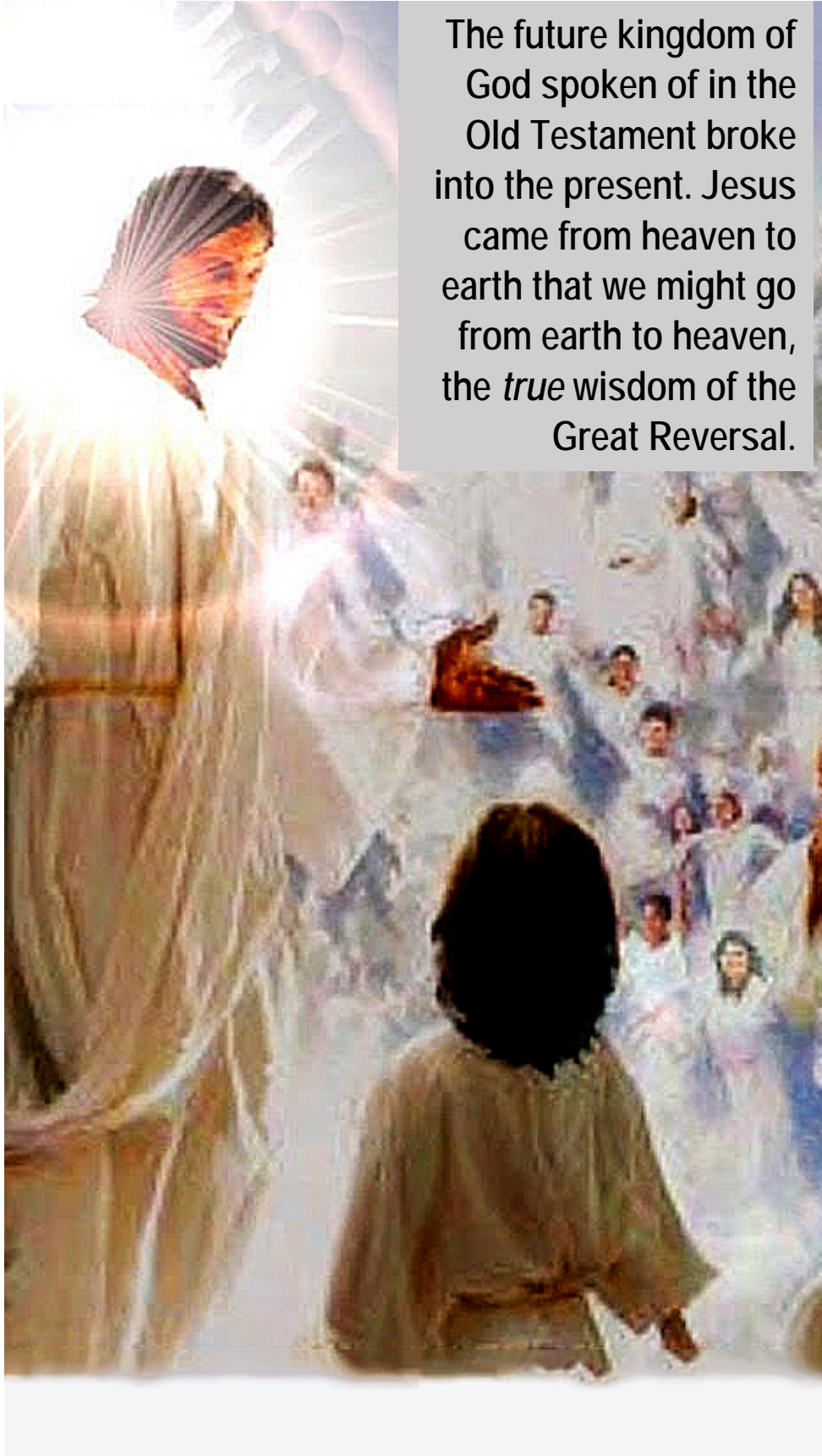
The violence and bloodshed of the

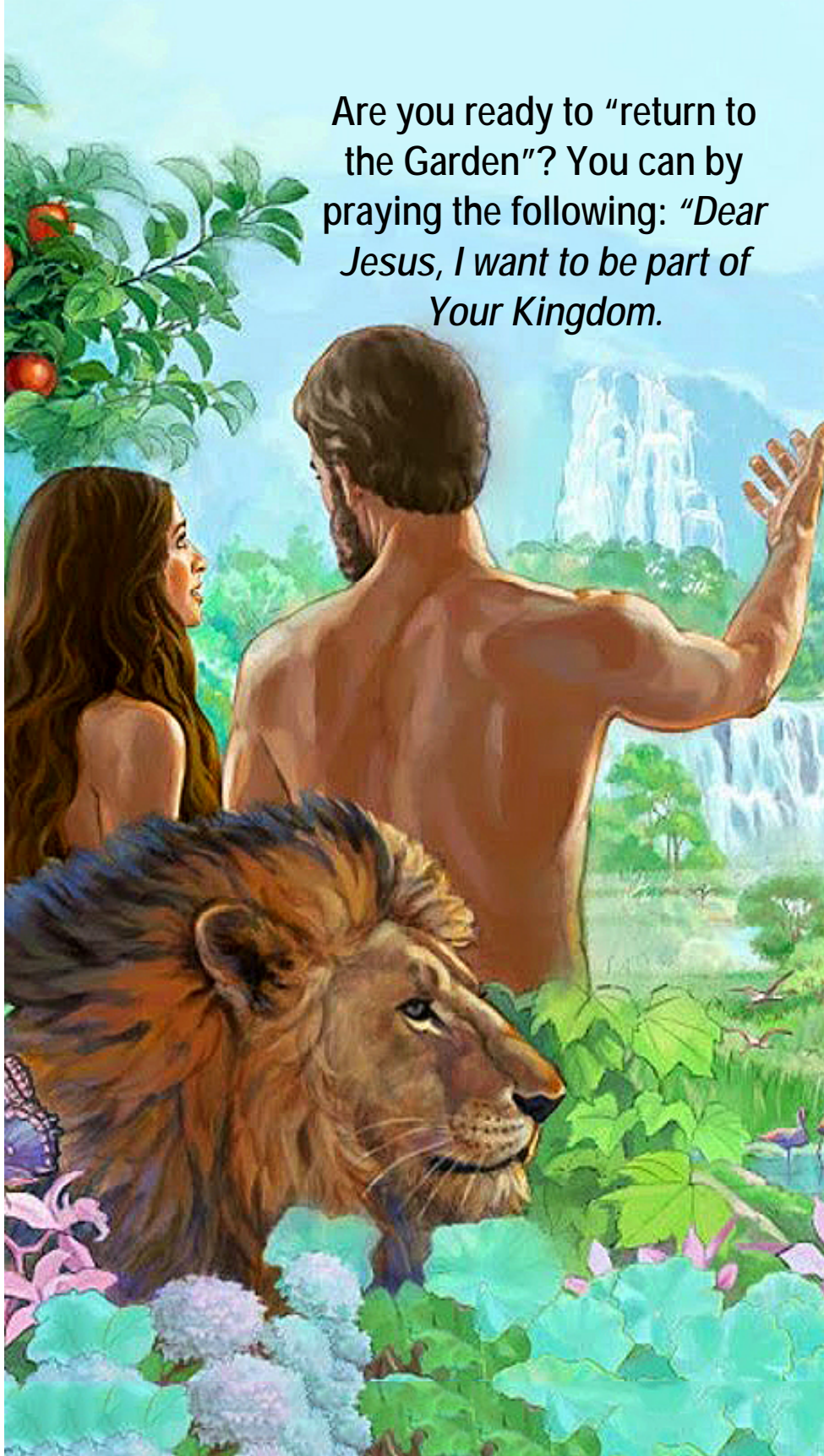


Jesus taught us to pray, "Thy kingdom come." It is not fully here yet —but it has begun.
