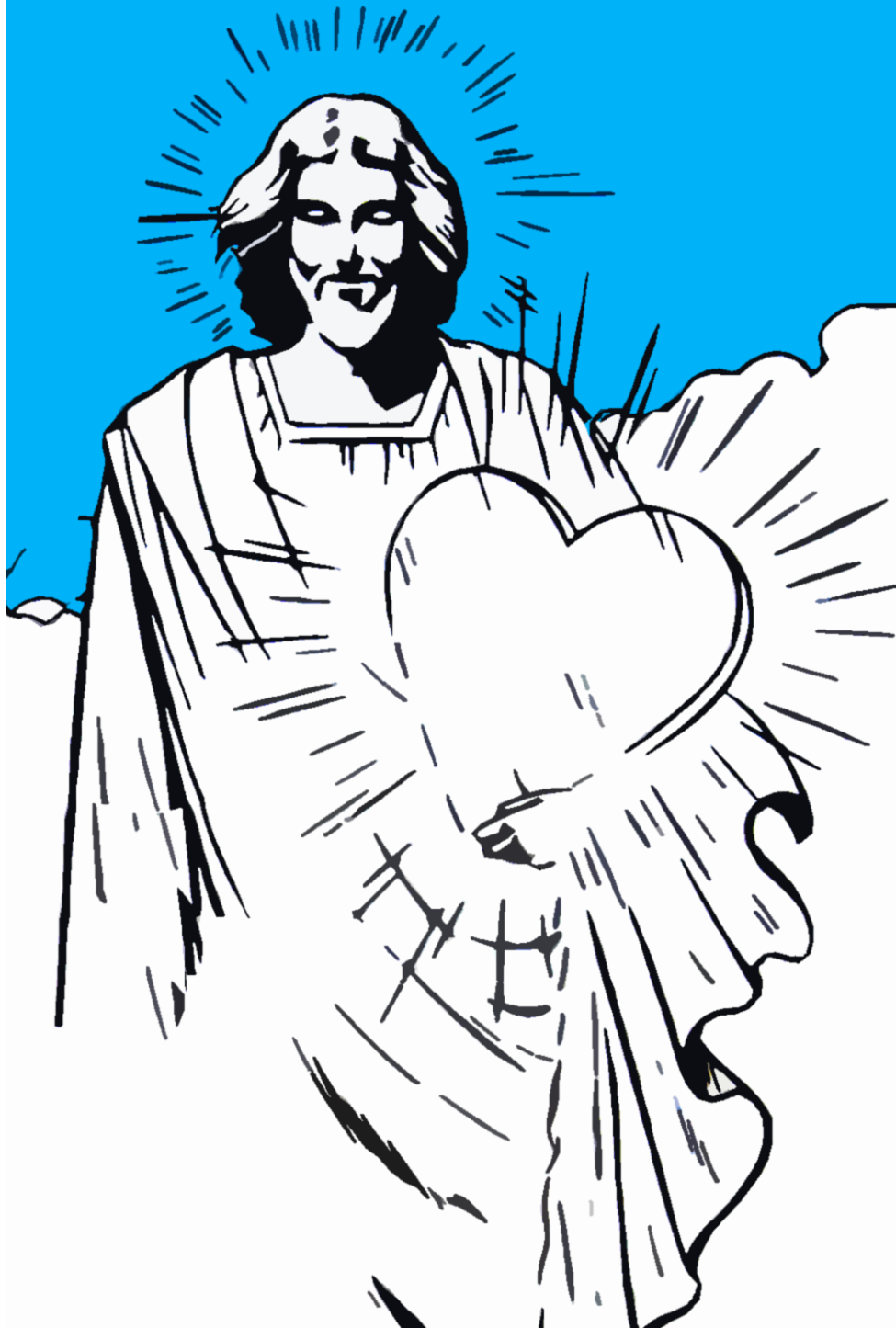
There is a special joy that comes from placing others and their needs above your own. Kind actions and deeds don't just benefit those who are on the receiving end—they also benefit you.
